

# EXO AND EXO PRO UPHOLSTERY INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### I. Parts included in the Kit:

a. Back Upholstery

#### 2. Tools required

a. Scissors


b. Tape measure

# **A** WARNING

Tension adjustable straps should be installed when chair is unfolded. DO NOT overtighten straps, as this will cause undue strain upon the chair frame. The difference in width between the top and bottom of the backrest should not exceed  $\pm -0.5$ " ( $\pm -0.5$ " ( $\pm -0.5$ ").

#### A. INSTALLING ADJUSTABLE UPHOLSTERY

- 1. Remove any existing upholstery
- Install top strap through the slot or hook in the push handles first (A). Cut to length. Figures 1 & 2
- 3. Mount the short side of the backrest straps. Figure 3
- Next mount the long side of the backrest straps to the opposite back post. Figure 4











- **6.** Mount the crocodile fixator (B). The fixator should be placed in the middle of the straps. Figures 5 & 6
- 7. Trim long strap as needed (C) for correct fixator placement. Figure 7
- 8. Install straps as required for specified height. Strap spacing should not exceed 1-1/2" (38mm).








#### **B. INSTALLING UPHOLSTERY AROUND BRACKETS**


- 1. Cut opening for Aluminum Side Guard, Carbon Side Guard, Desk Side Guard, or Half Folding Back.
- 2. Measure and cut slots on both sides (D) to clear side guard bracket or half folding back brackets. Figures 8 & 9






#### C. INSTALLING UPHOLSTERY AROUND ACCESSORIES

- 1. Cut opening for Height-Adjustable Push Handles, Auto-Fold Stablizer Bar, or Flip-Up Stablizer Bar.
- 2. Measure and cut openings on both sides (E) to go around push handle brackets or stablizer bar. Figure 10
- 3. Completed assembly of side covers. Figure 11 (Shown without cut-outs)











#### D. TOP PAD

1. Mount backrest pad (F). Figure 12

## **E. MOUNT COVER**

1. Fold cover over top strap. Adjust as needed to center the cover on the chair. Figures 13 & 14  $\,$ 

## F. INSPECT

- 1. Ensure that cut-outs clear brackets or accessories.
- 2. Ensure that straps and upholstery are centered on the chair.
- 3. Ensure that the difference in width between the top and bottom of the backrest does not exceed +/- 0.5" (+/- 13mm).
